

## The Flood Activity Sheet

Noah was a good man who loved God. He was a farmer who looked after his sheep, his land and other animals, and above all, his family. I don't suppose he ever imagined God would choose him to look after two of every animal, insect and bird in the world!!

Why not try these yummy sheep cakes: you can either make your own fairy cakes or buy some, then cover the top with butter icing and use mini marshmallows to make the fleece, use a chocolate button for the face and writing icing to make eyes.



Not all people were as good as Noah. They treated God's creation and one another badly. God decided to wash his world clean with a great flood.

He made sure that there was a male and female of every species of animal and bird saved on Noah's ark so that life could continue again.

Once the waters had drained away, God put a colourful rainbow in the sky as a sign that he promised he would never cover the whole earth in water again. Whenever we see a rainbow, we can remember that promise AND that God always keeps his promises.

Glue cotton wool buds onto half a paper plate or a paper/Card semi-circle. Attach to the straight side lengths of coloured paper to make a rainbow. The colours you will need are red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet.

However, he had made a promise never to flood the earth again. He is a forgiving God so when we mess things up, as long as we say sorry and do our best not to go wrong again, he forgives us (and if we do go wrong again, he forgives us, and again, and again, and again...!).

Why not make a rainbow promise mobile. On the raindrops, write a promise. It could be a promise to end a bad habit, or a promise to make a new friend, or a promise to help out at home – whatever you would like.

Simply colour a rainbow onto card and attach four lengths of string. To these attach raindrops big enough to write your promise.

Can you remember the colours?







God gets very sad when we treat each other badly. He made people to be loving and kind, just like him. A lovely idea to show love and kindness is to make a rainbow treat bag! Fill a bag with some rainbow sweet laces or rainbow coloured chews, some marshmallows (like the clouds) and some animal biscuits. Make a label which says 'GOD KEEPS HIS PROMISES' and give it to someone you love, or someone who has been shielding, or a neighbour.
